

## 2008 Lake George Watershed Conference Lake George Bookmark Design Contest



*Promote the protection and stewardship of Lake George and its amazing natural resources by encouraging students to participate in the 2008 LGWC Bookmark Design Contest!*

The Lake George Watershed Conference is looking for original artwork for the first annual Lake George Bookmark Design Contest. Entries are now being accepted from students attending schools that are part of the Lake George watershed.

All students in grades 4-7 attending the following schools are eligible for the contest: Whitehall, Lake George, Bolton, Ticonderoga, Queensbury, Fort Ann, and Lake Luzerne.

Bookmark themes should focus on any lake and watershed issues, and may include topics such as pollution, invasive species, aquatic and terrestrial plants and animals, streams and wetlands, lake ecology, water quality, and lake health.

- Finished bookmark size is 3" x 8". A template is provided on the entry form.
- Designs must be in color (crayon, colored pencil, marker, or watercolor) on unlined white paper.
- The winning design will be printed and distributed throughout the Lake George watershed.
- **The winning student will receive a free family pass for a steamboat ride on Lake George.**
- **The winning school will receive a set of Lake George related books for their library.**  
(selection will include titles such as: *Lake George Reflections* by Frank Leonbruno,  
*Nature's Frolic Hour: Appreciating Lake George* by Virginia Westbrook,  
*Lake George Boats and Steamboats* by Bill Gates and others)
